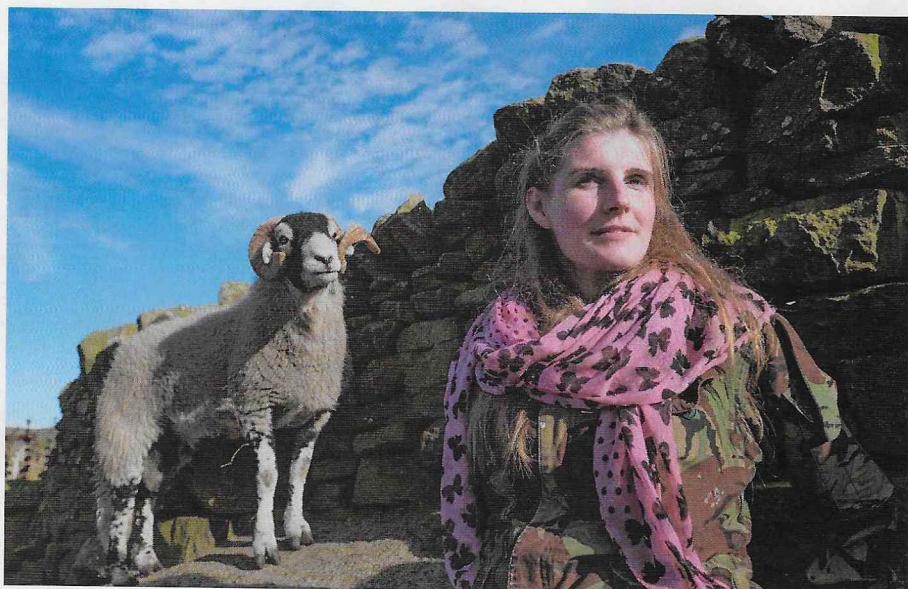

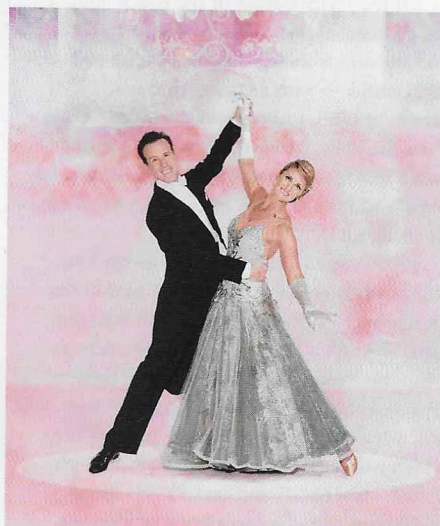


## ALONE IN BERLIN
